Highlights

TERMS OF REFERENCE, website policy and workplan were all reviewed in July. Committee will be submitting a motion to revise the website policy.

EMAIL COMMUNICATIONS – Committee discussed how Local 002 could build a government email list to contact members. This is an issue for Membership Services and Bargaining Committees. The easiest way would be for AUPE to provide an electronic file. Committee also discussed having a student enter names into a database.

CONVENTION LOGO WEAR – Committee purchased 72 hoodies for convention nominees and council members.

RETIREMENT PROGRAM – Since June 1, 2013, there have been 5 requests for retirement awards (pins/letters from the President).

ORIENTATION PACKAGES – Local 002 orientation packages include a welcome letter from Dennis Coulthard, a list of Chapter executive contacts, a description of the Anti-Privatization Committee and Bargaining information. These were just updated.
